Thembalami Care Centre and the Max Ordman Deaf Association (MODA) are set in secure, leafy grounds in Lombardy East, on the eastern side of Johannesburg. Peaceful gardens, mature trees and inviting outdoor spaces provide a beautiful, homely environment where residents can relax, connect and feel part of a caring community.





## Thembalami Care Centre

### Person-centred residential care

Thembalami provides care for older persons requiring support with daily living or nursing care. Each resident's needs, routines and preferences are respected, with care offered with dignity and compassion.

Residents enjoy safe, comfortable accommodation in north-facing double or single rooms. Two single rooms are linked to a shared bathroom, and all double rooms are en-suite. Rooms have garden or balcony access.

Daily life is enriched with social activities, gentle exercise, hobbies, outings and opportunities to engage with nature. Family and friends are welcome, and residents are encouraged to personalise their space with sentimental items.

### Facilities for comfortable living:

24-hour nursing care and security.

Inter-denominational chapel and library.

Dining rooms with balanced meals.

Recreational areas and craft/activity rooms.

Social activities and cultural events.

Snoezelen room (sensory stimulation)

Generator for continuous power supply



## Max Ordman Deaf Association (MODA)



### A home where communication is never a barrier

MODA provides care for older persons who are deaf in an inclusive and understanding environment. Staff and fellow residents use either sign language or supportive communication methods, ensuring connection and comfort.

MODA offers double or single rooms. Two single rooms are linked to a shared bathroom, and all double rooms are en-suite. Rooms have garden or balcony access.

The deaf community actively organises activities, and family visits are encouraged.

Emergency warning lights for the hearing impaired ensure safety on site.
